A simple step-by-step checklist to plan your siding project from first measurement to final walk-through, so nothing important slips through the cracks.



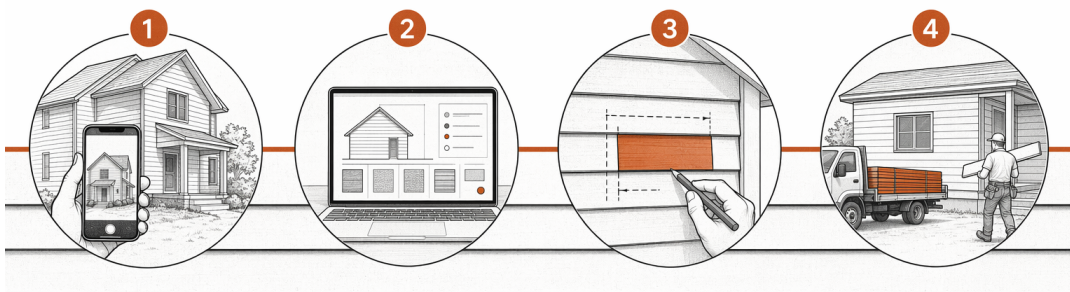
Before you call anyone

- Measure your approximate wall area
- Decide on a material range and budget window
- Note any known problem areas (rot, leaks, soft spots)



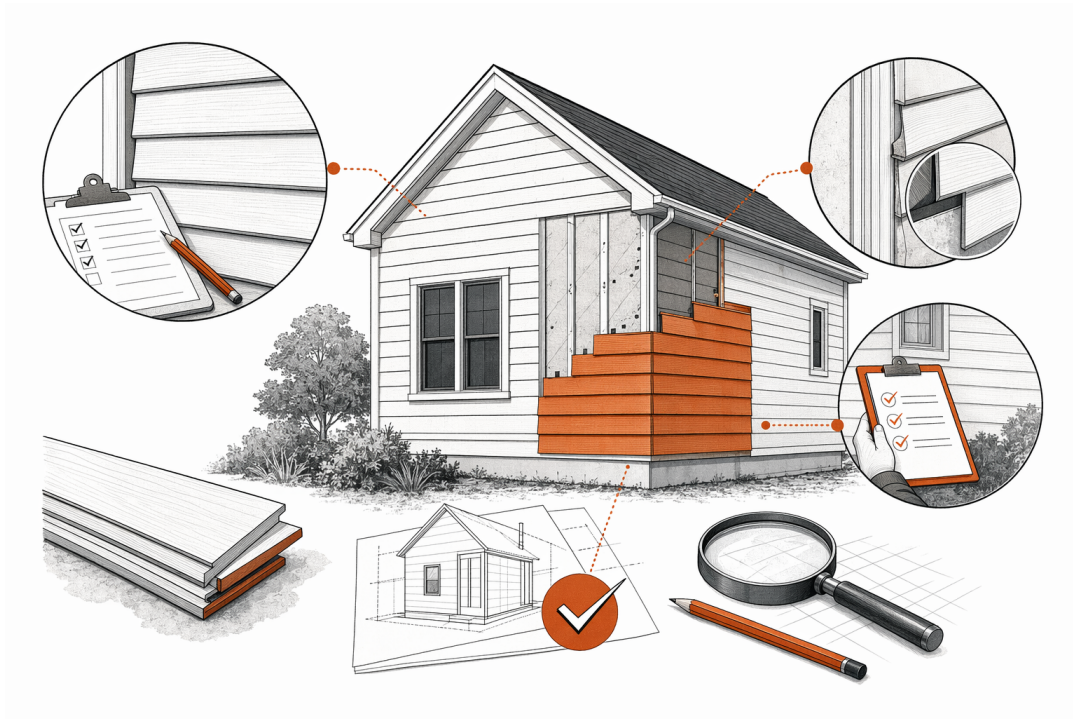
Choosing a contractor

- Get at least three written estimates
- Verify license, insurance, and bond yourself
- Check local references and recent work



Before work starts

- Signed contract with scope, price, and schedule
- Permit confirmed if required
- Clear expectations on removal, repairs, and cleanup



At the final walk-through

- Inspect trim, corners, and transitions
- Confirm cleanup and debris removal
- Get warranty paperwork in writing
