Three estimates can look very different and still be for the same house. This guide helps you line them up so you can compare the real value, not just the bottom number.



Put them side by side

List each estimate in three columns and compare these lines one by one.

- Material and product line
- Square footage measured
- Old-siding removal & disposal
- House wrap / flashing
- Trim, soffit, fascia
- Permit handling
- Workmanship & material warranty
- Payment schedule



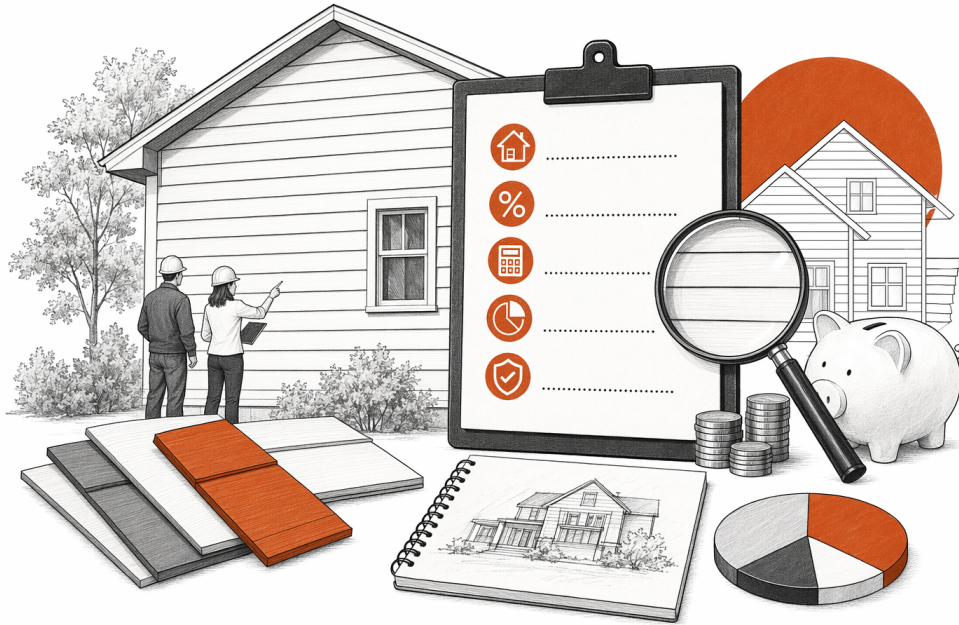
Why the cheapest can cost more

- What is the warranty on labor, not just material?



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
